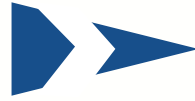

NOTICE OF RACE

- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS); the prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association; and the Sailing Instructions. Class Rules will apply, except where they differ from the Sailing Instructions.
- Alterations of the Racing Rules:** The Sailing Instructions will specifically identify alterations to the racing rules.
- Eligibility:** The following scows; MC, C, E, SIOD
- Schedule of Events:** (at right)
- Advertising:** Restricted to Category A (Appendix 1)
- Fees:** \$40 per boat US Sail member / \$45 per boat non US Sail member. Fee includes Regatta hat, Saturday evening Captain Morgan Bar & Oyster Roast, (one per boat) and keg beer after the races. (Additional Oyster Roast and drink tickets available for \$15).
- Sailing Instructions:** Available at Registration.
- Courses:** Diagrammed in the Sailing Instructions.
- Scoring:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules will apply.
- Alternative Penalties:** Rules 31, 44
- Decisions of the Jury:** Decisions of the jury will be final, in accordance with racing rule 70.4
- Prizes:** The number of trophies will be determined by the number of boats entered in each class per Sailing Instructions.
- JIYC will not be held responsible for any injury occurring on club grounds or on the water

GENERAL NOTES

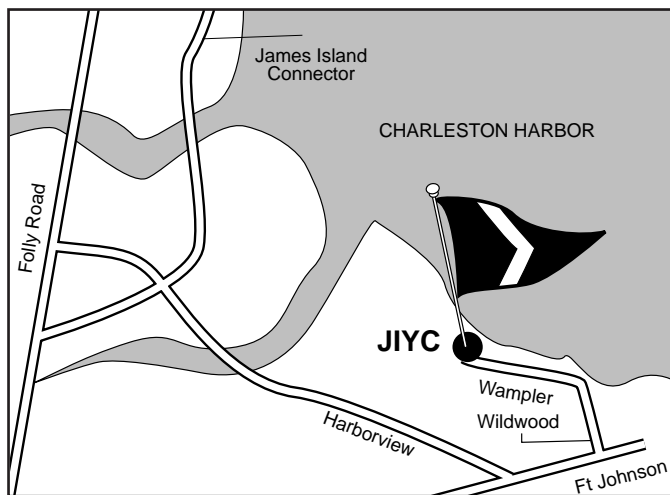
- Camping will be permitted on grounds (primitive only).
