

Notes to Our Thursday Evening Guests

The Sailing Committee with the approval of the Board of Directors of James Island Yacht Club has graciously opened the Club Grounds to the sailing community of the greater Charleston area for our Summer Thursday Sailing Series. As many of you will be unfamiliar with the policies of JIYC, we ask that you keep the following guidelines in mind:

The gate at the entrance to the club may be closed. We plan to have someone at the gate allowing you to enter. Should a member not be present, you may use the call button on the gate card reader to speak with the bar staff.

Please do not enter the Clubhouse Lounge unless accompanied by a member of the James Island Yacht Club.

Minor children are not allowed in the lounge at any time.

The Club's restrooms may be entered through the outside doors located to the left of the main entrance or through the sunroom at the west side of the building.

PETS AND BROWN BAGGING ARE PROHIBITED! Please purchase your beverage of choice from the pass-through service window located on the deck on the harbor side of the building. The bar accepts cash, Master Card, Visa, and Discover.

Boats must be removed from the Club grounds each Thursday. Special arrangements may be made on Thursdays immediately preceding harbor regattas if you are planning to sail in that event. In this case, boats must be removed Sunday afternoon.
