

Notice of Race  
James Island Y-Flyer/Laser and Friends Frostbite Series  
Dates: January 10 – March 21, 2021

**COVID -19 Disclaimer:**

The James Island Yacht Club (JIYC) is holding this series with several modifications due to the COVID-19 pandemic. We will follow the CDC, State of South Carolina and local recommendations during this time such as social distancing, frequent hand washing and the use of a face mask especially when on club grounds. The safety of our members, guests and staff are the driving force for the modifications to this event. We will monitor the situation daily and make appropriate changes as needed.

**1. RULES:**

- 1.1 This series will be governed by current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020* (RRS).
- 1.2 The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.
- 1.3 Appendix V will be in effect.

**2. ELIGIBILITY:**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Y Flyers, Hobie Wave, Laser/ILCA, 420, Bic, Opti and Lightnings.
- 2.2 All boats may launch from James Island Yacht Club or another club if preferred.

**3. REGISTRATION:**

- 3.1 Informal registration will begin each Sunday during the series at 1200 at JIYC, at or near the sailing shed.
- 3.2 There will be a fee for non JIYC club members. The series of \$60 per boat (\$10 per scheduled race day).
- 3.3 JIYC has 3 club Lasers available for daily charter. Contact Rob in advance to reserve or first come/first serve w/JIYC members having priority on race day. Fee is \$10 per day.

**4. SCHEDULE:**

- 4.1 The series consist of racing on 6 different Sunday afternoons. January 10, 24, February 7, 21, March 7, 21.
- 4.2 First warning signal will be 1300 for first class. Other class will follow.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND AREA:**

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions and course diagrams for each afternoon will be available at the official notice board, next to the door of the sailing shed at JIYC no later than 1200.
- 5.2 All courses will be in Charleston Harbor, starting and finishing at or near the JIYC dock.

**6. SCORING:**

- 6.1 Each Sunday's race or races will determine that day's position.
- 6.2 Each day position will be added up to determine the final series results.
- 6.3 If we have all 6 days of racing, a boats worst day finished will be dropped.
- 6.4 If boats are tied, the lowest sum of all races will break the tie. If boats are still tied, then the boat that beat the other in the last race wins the tie break.

**7. PRIZES:**

- 7.1 The number of trophies awarded will be determined by the number of boats entering each class, as described in the Sailing Instructions.

**8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:**

- 8.1 Competitors participate in this series entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. James Island Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
